1	<b>Recall:</b> Student recalls facts, information, procedures, or definitions.	define; identify; name; select; state; order; one step	SWBAT <i>name</i> the 3 cues for the overhand serve in volleyball.
2	<b>Basic Application of Skill/Concept:</b> Student uses information, conceptual knowledge, and procedures.	apply; choose; compute; employ; interpret; graph; modify; operate; plot; practice; solve; use; two or more steps	SWBAT <i>apply</i> a defensive strategy from soccer to another invasion game.
3	<b>Strategic Thinking:</b> Student uses reasoning and develops a plan or sequence of steps; process has some complexity.	compare; contrast; correlate; differentiate; discriminate; examine; infer; maximize; minimize; prioritize; subdivide; test	SWBAT <i>subdivide</i> a skill into its key phases and <i>compare</i> them to another skill we learned.
4	<b>Extended Thinking:</b> Student conducts an investigation, needs time to think and process multiple conditions of the problem or task.	arrange; collect; construct; design; develop; formulate; organize; set up; prepare; plan; propose; create experiment and record data	SWBAT <i>construct</i> a new dance routine using skills learned in class.
